



Certification of Clear Ballot Group ClearVote 2.2

On January 11, 2022 Clear Ballot Group requested certification of ClearVote 2.2 and associated software and firmware, for use in Washington State.

Upon examination of the system, the Secretary of State finds ClearVote 2.2 satisfies the requirements of Washington State law and has been tested and reviewed by an independent testing authority designated by the United States Election Assistance Commission and, other than functions or capabilities unique to this state.
