I am in receipt of your subpoena and of your letter which according to my legal counsel, Mr. Hanna, was handed him at about 11:30 a. m., on Friday, August 22, 1980.

I have directed my chief of staff, Mr. Paul Bender, to instruct all staff members who would in any way have knowledge of or have in their possession any of the items set forth in your subpoena to supply that information for the packet which will be delivered to you.

In addition, staff members responsible for the keeping of the records connected with the operation of my office since my term have been asked to research files in the archives which could in any way contain material requested in your subpoena.

May I again assure you as I have publicly stated, that I would be immediately responsive to any request for me to attend court and testify under oath during the course of the federal case now under way.

In compliance with your letter, the records requested will be delivered to you (or the court) at 9:30 a. m., Monday, August 25, 1980, by H. B. Hanna, my legal counsel.
