The following notes pertain to all sections of the 2016 Washington Public Library Statistical Report.

- Population figures are based on data from the State of Washington, Office of Financial Management publication: 2016 Population Trends, September 2016.
- b) Percent of Change figures are calculated by comparing 2016 numbers against 2015, using the following formula:

(2016 value - 2015 value) / 2015 value.

- c) Subtotals are the calculation for each library population grouping and the Grand Total is the calculation for all libraries in the state.
- d) Assessed valuation figures are based on data from the Department of Revenue publication: Property Tax Statistics 2016, September 2016.
- e) Regular Levy Rates are actual levy rates for library districts.
- f) Local Cents per \$1,000 is the calculated levy rate for cities, using the following formula: (Local Jurisdiction Revenue / Assessed Municipal Valuations) * 1000.
- g) 2017 Salary Figures (Table 21) are shown in dollars per hour.
- h) The Salary and Compensation Survey was combined with the Annual Statistical Data Survey for ease of submission for libraries. As a result, the data for the Salary and Compensation Survey uses 2017 figures, whereas the Annual Statistical Data Survey uses 2016.
