ARTICLE I. There shall be perfect peace and amicable friendship between the government of the United States of America and the government of the Republic of Paraguay...

ARTICLE II. The Republic of Paraguay, in the exercise of the sovereign right which pertains to her, according to the provisions of the Constitution of the United States of America...

ARTICLE III. The two high contracting parties hereby agree that any favor, privilege, or immunity whatever, in matters of commerce or navigation...

ARTICLE IV. No other or higher duties shall be imposed on the importation or exportation of any article...

ARTICLE V. No other or higher duties or charges on account of tonnage, light, or harbor dues, pilotage, salvage in case of damage or shipwreck...

ARTICLE VI. The same duties shall be paid upon the importation and exportation of any article which is or may be legally importable or exportable...

ARTICLE VII. All vessels which, according to the laws of the United States of America, are to be deemed vessels of the United States of America...

ARTICLE VIII. Citizens of the United States of America shall pay, in territories of the Republic of Paraguay, the same import and export duties...

ARTICLE IX. All merchants, commanders of ships, and others, the citizens of each country, respectively, shall have full liberty, in all the territories of the one country...

ARTICLE X. In whatever relates to the police of the ports, the landing or unloading of ships, the warehousing and safety of merchandise, goods, and effects...

ARTICLE XI. Wherein the government of the United States of America, in the exercise of the sovereign right...

ARTICLE XII. In the event of any citizen of either of the two contracting parties dying without will or testament...
