WHEREAS, a treaty between the United States of America and His Majesty the Shah of Persia...

ARTICLE V. All suits and disputes arising in Persia between citizens of the United States...

ARTICLE VI. In case of a citizen or subject of either of the contracting parties dying within the territories of the other...

ARTICLE VII. For the protection of their citizens or subjects in either country...

ARTICLE VIII. And the high contracting parties agree that the present treaty of friendship...

ARTICLE IX. In faith of which, the respective plenipotentiaries of the two high contracting parties...

ARTICLE X. And the high contracting parties agree to exchange the ratifications of their respective governments...
