The Democratic Convention for Washington Territory met at Kalama Sept. 15. Judge J. D. Mix, of Walla Walla, was chosen chairman...

Resolved: That we endorse the nomination of the soldier-statesman, Winfield Scott Hancock, and his worthy compeer, W. H. English...

Resolved: That we are in favor of a speedy admission of the Territory of Washington into the Union as a State...

Clark, of Pierce, presented Judge Thos. Burke, of Seattle, as Delegate to Congress.

White, of King, moved that Judge J. A. Kuhn of Port Townsend, be elected chairman of the Territorial central committee...

Kuhn, of Jefferson, offered the following resolution: Whereas the Democracy of the Territory of Washington has maintained its organization for years...

Whereas the population of our Territory has increased to such a number that our admission as a State cannot be much longer delayed...

Resolved: That a committee of three be appointed by this convention to communicate with the national Democratic committee...

Adopted with the amendment that the central committee shall constitute the committee called for by the resolution.

A resolution thanking the Oregon Railway and Navigation company and the Northern-Pacific R. R. for favors extended, was passed.
