WALLA WALLA AS AN EDUCATIONAL CENTER. The New Whitman College as it will appear when finished--A Model Institution and an Ornament to the City--An \$15,000 Structure.

In the office of Messrs. Allen & Whitmore, architects, can be seen the plans and specifications of the proposed new Whitman College building...

From the first floor you ascend to the second story by means of a fine stairway eight feet wide. It might be mentioned that the basement can be reached by a passage under the portico on the outside and by a stairway leading from the first floor on the inside of the building.

Ascending to the third floor we find a college society room, 25x34 feet, a library room of the same dimensions, two dormitories 17x22 feet, a music room 16x25 feet, and a drawing and painting room 16x25 feet.

It is estimated that when finished this fine educational building will cost something like \$18,000. It is but the beginning of a series of three structures that are to be built by this society for educational purposes...

On Thursday afternoon last the Whitman College closed a most prosperous year, during which time 119 pupils have been on the roll.

During the year the institution has been organized on a college basis, with a freshman class, college preparatory classes, a normal course and a purely English course.

With the aid of the American College Society, Whitman College and Seminary, with a liberal charter which gives it a right to locate at any place within the limits of the extensive county of Walla Walla...
