Our Next Interest.

In a discussion on the fence question a few days since, we gathered much valuable information regarding the magnitude of the stock interests of this section of Washington Territory.

In regard to our other next interest, it may be as well to state that late in sheep are killed unless they are from two to four years old, and no more ewes or yearlings will be butchered hereafter.

The following resolution has been introduced in the Legislative Council by the Hon. N. T. Eaton, of Walla Walla.

RESOLUTION—CREATING A JOINT COMMITTEE ON RAILROADS.

WHEREAS, The Organic Act of Washington Territory provides that all taxes shall be uniform and equal, and

WHEREAS, The decision of some of the Courts under existing laws with relation to the taxation of the property of railroad corporations, particularly that of the Northern Pacific Railroad Company, is such as to leave the impression upon the public mind that such property of such corporations, in consequence of a defect in the law, escapes taxation;

The lands already owned by the Northern Pacific Railroad Company, because patent has not issued up to now, when the lands are sold to a private individual, the assessor is allowed to list the same:

The other property of corporations, by virtue of a supposed exemption, is permitted to escape, while that of the private citizen is listed at its full value, thus practically evading, if not directly disregarding the explicit declaration of the Organic Act of 1854, and

WHEREAS, The plain unmistakable intention of Congress, as expressed in the Organic Act, was that no distinction should be made:

That all property should bear its equal burden of taxation whether owned by corporations or private citizens, and for this purpose ought to be listed alike where no act of Congress prohibits, and

WHEREAS, The Revenue laws of the Territory need revision and amendment so as to correct the wrong herein indicated and more fully and justly comply with the wise and impartial provisions of the Organic Act on the subject of taxation. Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Council, the House concurring, That a Joint Committee of Five, two on the part of the Council and three on the part of the House, be appointed and designated as the Joint Committee on Revenue.

That the duties of such committee are defined as follows: Carefully consider the Revenue laws of the Territory and to prepare and submit such revision thereof, or amendments thereto, as will effectuate the objects set forth in the preamble hereto and prevent any and all evasions of the Organic Act upon the subject of taxation.
