Grave doubts exist in the minds of wheat dealers whether the European markets will be much longer available for our surplus wheat.

Supposing the fact of an European deficiency to be correctly reported, there are only two obvious explanations for this state of things—a conviction abroad that prices in America are going to rise lower, or the large development of new supply markets in other parts of the world.

A reasonable computation of product and consumption does not leave a greater surplus this year than Europe ought to take, by the rule of previous years.

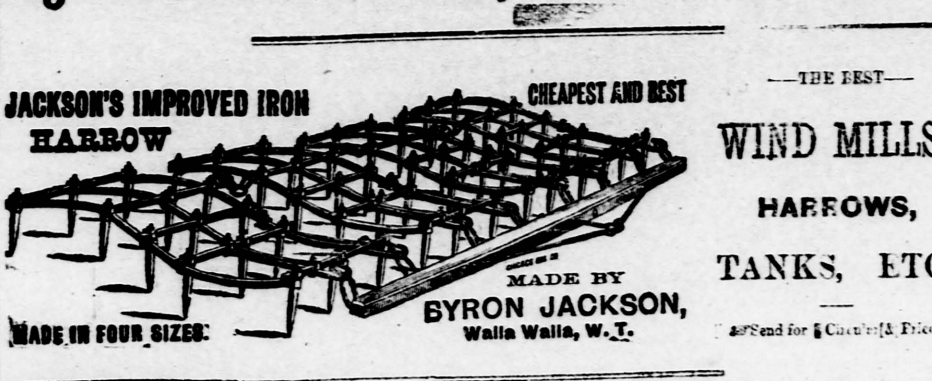

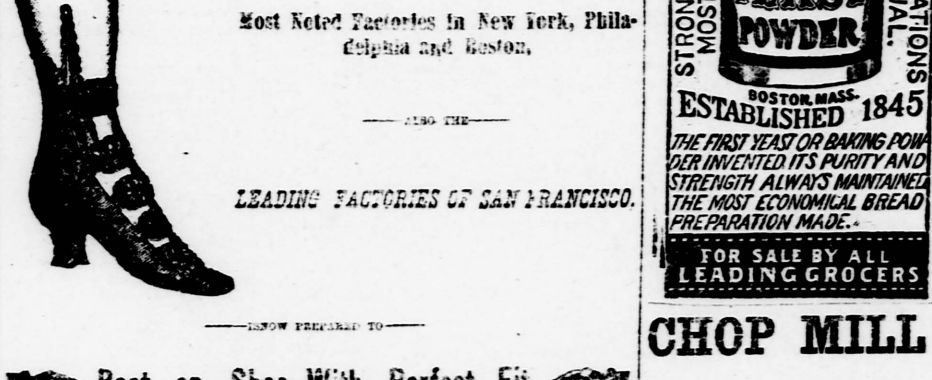
