The trade in this city with packers from the different mining camps is improving rapidly. Many packers come here now from Auburn and Boise mines in preference from Auburn and Boise mines in preterence to going elsewhere. The low rates of river freights now ruling, is the reason why our trade is increasing with packers.
