Indian Massacres.

Mr. Barnett, of the Powder River express, brings intelligence that previous to his departure from Auburn, on Monday, a report was in circulation there that fifty-six miners had been murdered by the Snake Indians.

Notwithstanding the precautions taken by the government in providing military protection for emigrants, it is already evident that the present year's emigration has suffered as severely from Indian depredations as at any previous year, and the sequel may show that they have fared far worse.
