Ferguson, Attorney General, and 13 David M. Horn, Senior Counsel, files this Assurance of Discontinuance pursuant to 14 RCW 19.86.100. 15 The Attorney General initiated an investigation into the registration and 1. 16 solicitation practices of the Respondent, Silver Flight Ensembles, a Washington nonprofit 17 corporation based in King County, Washington. 18 2. The Attorney General deems the following to constitute unfair or deceptive acts or 19 practices in violation of the Consumer Protection Act, RCW 19.86.020, and the Charitable 20 Solicitations Act, RCW 19.09.065(1) and RCW 19.09.100(12): 21 a. Soliciting or collecting charitable contributions from the 22 general public without first registering as a charitable organization with the Washington Secretary of State as 23 required by 19.09.065(1) and 19.09.100(12). 24 25 26

- 3. Respondent has recently registered as a charitable organization with the Charities Division of the Washington Secretary of State and agrees to maintain registration status with the Washington Secretary of State for as long as it is required by law to do so.
- 4. Respondent agrees to pay the costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Attorney General in pursuing this matter in the amount of \$500.00 (FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS), payable in full upon signing this Assurance of Discontinuance. Payment shall be made by valid cashier's check, paid to the order of Attorney General—State of Washington.
- 5. Respondent shall send the signed Assurance of Discontinuance, the Order, and a cashier's check to the Office of the Attorney General, Attention: Margaret Farmer, Consumer Protection Division, 800 Fifth Avenue, Suite 2000, Seattle, Washington, 98104.
- 6. This Assurance of Discontinuance shall not be considered an admission of violation of the Consumer Protection Act or the Charitable Solicitations Act for any purpose, but failure to comply with this Assurance of Discontinuance shall be *prima facie* evidence of violation of RCW 19.86.020, for which the violator, Silver Flight Ensembles, and its officers, directors, and principals, may be found liable by the Court for injunctions, restitution, civil penalties of up to \$2,000.00 per violation, and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Attorney General in pursuing such action.
- 7. Under no circumstances may this Assurance of Discontinuance or the name of the State of Washington, the Office of the Attorney General, the Washington Secretary of State, or any of its employees or representatives be used by the Respondent or by its officers, employees, representatives, or agents in conjunction with any business or charitable activity of the Respondent, including but not limited to claiming that the State has approved of Respondent's business, charitable, or charitable solicitation practices.
