

**SUBJECT: MEMBERSHIP IN THE WASHINGTON STATE
REPUBLICAN PARTY**

POLICY:

The following persons will be considered members of the WSRP:

1. Members of the State Committee and State Executive Board.
2. Republican Precinct Committee Officers and Precinct Chairmen.
3. Individuals who have contributed to the WSRP in the last four calendar years.
4. Individual Party Members self-described as Republicans based on Voter Vault identification programs.
5. Participants in the biennial convention process within the preceding four years, including precinct caucus attendees, delegates and alternates to county conventions, delegates and alternates to the state convention and delegates and alternates to the national convention.
6. Other individuals who have affirmatively state their intentions to become members of the Washington State Republican Party, and who have demonstrated support of the party, its candidates and programs.
7. Elected Republican officials.
8. Recognized Republican Auxiliary Organizations.

6. Other individuals who have affirmatively state their intentions to become members of the Washington State Republican Party, and who have demonstrated support of the party, its candidates and programs.
7. Elected Republican officials.
8. Recognized Republican Auxiliary Organizations.
