



**APPROVAL OF MODIFICATIONS TO A CENTRAL COUNT DIGITAL SCAN SYSTEM
AND DIRECT RECORDING ELECTRONIC VOTE TALLYING SYSTEM**

In July 2008, Sequoia Voting Systems requested the approval (under WAC 434-335-170) of an upgrade to the Audio Box Unit (ABU) used with the Edge II Accessible Voting Unit to firmware version 8.7.5. Improvements have been made to improve quality issues. The issue corrected pertains to scratches and pops due to data throughput which needs to be faster than the ABU code could process in the machines.

Sequoia submitted the Audio Box Unit for testing by iBeta, a Voting System Test Laboratory (VSTL) fully certified by the Election Assistance Commission (EAC). iBeta states that the source code has been reviewed against the 2002 Voting System Standards requirements for voting code static review and there are no discrepancies.

After reviewing the iBeta report, the upgrade to the Audio Box Unit meets the requirements of WAC 434-335-160 for administrative approval. The Office of the Secretary of State hereby approves it for use by County Governments of the State of Washington when used in compliance with the procedures contained in the voting system certification and Washington State law.
