important information

This special absentee ballot application cannot be submitted more than 90 days prior to the election. You will also be sent your regularly-issued ballot and may choose to vote it if received in time. If both your regularly-issued and special absentee ballots are voted and received in time to be valid, your county elections department will reject your special absentee ballot and count your regularly-issued ballot.

Your voted ballot must be postmarked no later than the date of the election or it will not be counted.
