1 The parties, having met and conferred, hereby stipulate to rescheduling the trial date in
2 this matter from October 4, 2010 to November 15, 2010, subject to the Court's approval.

3 In addition, please be advised that the parties have agreed to stay all discovery for five
4 weeks (35 days) in order to focus their efforts on the prospects of settlement. As a result:

- 6 ■ Discovery will be neither propounded nor responded to for a period of 35 days,
beginning on May 5, 2010 and extending through June 8, 2010;
- 7 ■ With respect to discovery already propounded, the 30-day time to respond will resume,
8 with time elapsed, on June 9, 2010. Consequently:
 - 9 ○ State Defendant Intervenors' responses to discovery propounded by Plaintiffs
and Plaintiff Intervenors on April 30 will be due July 6;
 - 10 ○ Plaintiffs' and Plaintiff Intervenors' responses to discovery propounded by State
Defendant Intervenors on May 4 will be due July 8;
- 11 ■ Deadline to propound written discovery: June 9, 2010;
- 12 ■ Deadline to exhaust written discovery: July 16, 2010 [120 days prior to trial];
- 13 ■ Deadline to conduct fact witness depositions: August 17, 2010
- 14 ■ Deadline to conduct expert depositions: August 20, 2010
- 15 ■ Deadline for dispositive motions: August 26, 2010 [81 days prior to trial].

16 Having been authorized to make this submission on behalf of plaintiffs, plaintiff
17 intervenors, defendants, and defendant intervenors, respectively, the undersigned hereby
18 respectfully submits this joint stipulation for the Court's approval.
