





Executive Summary. In July, the number of active, registered voters rose for the seventh straight month, reaching 3,408,943. This is 73.9% of our estimated voting eligible population of 4,614,253 (source: elections.gmu.edu) and 97.1% of the number we had for the 2004 general election. The age and gender composition of our electorate did not change significantly since last month's report.
