The court considered the petitions, briefs, and all materials filed for the ballot title challenges regarding Initiatives 1504 through 1508. The court heard oral argument on April 13, 2016. The court finds that the ballot titles formulated by the Attorney General's Office:

Ballot Title

Initiative Measure No. ¹⁵⁰⁴ ¹⁵⁰⁵ 1506 concerns gender-segregated facilities and civil liability.

^{1507 and 1508}
This measure would repeal protections against gender-identity discrimination in certain public-accommodation facilities, require that public schools restrict use of specific facilities based on anatomy or chromosomal sex, and allow student lawsuits against schools.

1 **Ballot Measure Summary**

2 This measure would repeal Human Rights Commission rules interpreting the Law Against
3 Discrimination as allowing people to use gender-segregated facilities based on gender-identity,
4 restrict similar local laws, and state that, with exceptions, the law does not require allowing use of
5 "private facilities" based on gender-identity. It requires that use of certain public-school facilities
6 be restricted based on birth anatomy or chromosomes, and authorizes lawsuits against schools
7 that grant students access to those facilities based on gender-identity.
