9 **BALLOT MEASURE SUMMARY I-1491**

10 This measure would authorize courts, upon petition by police or a "family or household
11 member," to issue an "extreme risk protection order" to prevent an individual from accessing
12 firearms for a specified time period, if the court finds that the individual poses a significant
13 danger of causing personal injury to himself or others with a firearm. Temporary ex parte
14 orders could be issued where there is sufficient evidence of significant danger in the near
15 future.






