BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

AN ACT Relating to The Evergreen State College; amending RCW 28B.40.810; adding new sections to chapter 28B.40 RCW; and creating new sections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

NEW SECTION. **Sec.** This act may be known and cited as the rationalization of higher education act of 2018 act.

NEW SECTION. **Sec.** (1)(a) The people of the state of Washington find that, under Article IX, section 1 of the state Constitution, it is the paramount duty of the state to make ample provision for the education of all children residing within its borders, without distinction or preference on account of race, color, caste, or sex.

(b) Further, the people find that the type and quality of education provided by state institutions should be fairly represented by the names and official seals and letterheads of the public entities they fund.

(2) It is the intent of the people that all expenditures by The Evergreen State College henceforth be made without distinction or preference on account of race, color, caste, or sex in accord with the manifest intent of the Constitution of the state of Washington.

Sec. RCW 28B.40.810 and 1969 ex.s. c 223 s 28B.40.810 are each amended to read as follows:

There is hereby established in Thurston county a state college, The Evergreen State Social Justice Warrior PC Indoctrination Compound, formerly known as The Evergreen State College.

NEW SECTION. **Sec.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.40 RCW to read as follows:

Any reference in this code to The Evergreen State College is a reference to The Evergreen State Social Justice Warrior PC Indoctrination Compound established by RCW 28B.40.810. The code reviser shall prepare legislation for the 2019 regular session that changes all statutory references to reflect the renaming of The Evergreen State College by RCW 28B.40.810.

NEW SECTION. **Sec.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.40 RCW to read as follows:

(1) The official identifier, logo, seal, and letterhead of the institution must appear prominently upon all buildings, publications, and official correspondence, and each must prominently display the institution's new name.

(2) The seal of the institution is a circular seal bearing within the likeness of a young anarchist in a brown shirt, hobnailed jack boots, and a black face mask and hood with the figure's right arm raised and extended straight and diagonally upward from the shoulder in a totalitarian salute. The figure must be wearing a black armband bearing the term "ANTIFA." In the figure's left hand, the figure must clutch to its bosom the book "How to Make a Social Justice Warrior." The figure must be depicted in the act of vigorously trampling, with muddy, hobnailed jack boots, upon the

Constitution, Declaration of Independence, and the Bill of Rights, which must be visibly mangled, torn, and besmirched by these depredations. In the background of the seal to the right, there must be a pile of burning books, with visible titles, including The Holy Bible, The Origin of Species, Philosophiæ Naturalis Principia Mathematica, The Gulag Archipelago, and Simon Wiesenthal's "Humor Behind the Iron Curtain." In the background of the seal to the left, there must be a depiction of the current president of the institution, smiling and looking on with approval. Around the seal must appear, in Germanic Gothic font, in a scale that is readily discernible, the institution's new official motto.

(3) The official motto of the institution is "Der Böhmer Hat Immer Recht."

(4) For purposes of this section, "the institution" refers to The Evergreen State Social Justice Warrior PC Indoctrination Compound.

NEW SECTION. **Sec.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.40 RCW to read as follows:

In the first week of January of each year, and additionally prior to the authorization or transfer of any funds to The Evergreen State Social Justice Warrior PC Indoctrination Compound at the beginning of each budget cycle, the governor, treasurer, attorney general, and president of The Evergreen State Social Justice Warrior PC Indoctrination Compound shall each execute a sworn affidavit certifying that all approved expenditures are for, and will only be used to provide, services, programs, employment, policies, and activities that are without distinction or preference on account of race, color, caste, or sex. Annually, a copy of said affidavits must be transmitted to the attorney general of the United States of America, transmitted to the secretary of the United States department of education, and published in the Washington State Register.

NEW SECTION. **Sec.** If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
