Dear Parents:

The Curtis High School Library received five Kindle eReaders this year through the funding of a grant proposal. Each Kindle has six-eight books on it in a variety of genres selected based on the reading interests of high school students.

Your student has expressed an interest in being able to borrow a Kindle. As is our practice when loaning other technologies, we are asking parents to give their permission for their student to borrow a Kindle, and to accept financial responsibility for loss and/or damage to the eReader belonging to the school while it is in your student's care.

The value of each Kindle, 6-8 books, and the protective leather cover is \$295.00. Students will be given clear instructions in the care of the Kindle before they borrow one. Please read borrowing rules on the reverse. Because we only have 5 Kindles and they are in high demand, the loan period is two weeks. No renewals are available and there is a \$2.00 per day overdue fine if the Kindle is not returned on time.
