



## Employee saves LCB thousands with new suggestion



As a Telecommunications Coordinator for the Liquor Control Board, Erasmus "Skip" Leingang noticed that each store had an alarm system that was connected to its own stand-alone line, and these extra lines were costing the organization thousands of dollars in unneeded charges.

Leingang suggested that the agency switch the alarm systems in each store to the main number, eliminating the need for the extra phone lines.

Upon implementing this suggestion, the Liquor Control Board forecasted a first-year savings of \$71,740, and continued its efforts to improve the way the agency does business.
