3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 The Pacific chorus frog, *Pseudacris regilla*, is hereby designated
7 as the official amphibian of the state of Washington.
