






VOTER REGISTRATION REPORT - February 23, 2007

Executive Summary. We have 3,278,225 active registered voters. The number of active registered voters increased in 25 counties since last month.

Estimate of the statewide percentage of eligible citizens that are actively registered to vote: 72.8%.
