





Executive Summary. The number of active registered voters is down by 28,158 since last month, to 3,275,657.

The registration of 19,320 new voters was counteracted by 47,478 cancellations and inactivations. The large number of inactivations and a .3% decrease in the percentage of voters ages 25-44 most likely reflects the seasonal residential mobility of that age group.

Estimate of the statewide percentage of eligible citizens that are actively registered is down .3, to 73.0%.
