The Douglis County Tragedy. The following from our Roseburg correspondent, says the Jacksonville Press, gives a tolerably clear account of the late desperate affair near the place:

ROSEBURG, January 1st, 1867. MA. SUTTON.—Our quiet village is the scene of gloom and sorrow, caused by an awful tragedy that took place in Cole's Valley precinct on the 26th ult. The circumstances, as they are reported, are as follows: There was a difficulty existing between a man by the name of Bennett and one by the name of Colver. They lived three or four miles apart. On the eve of Christmas a holiday party was given at Colver's, and one of Bennett's, where Bennett resided. The party was organized by Bennett under the management of Mr. Frank Baranger. Bennett and his party expected a row, and prepared to have it where it finally came off. About 1 o'clock, A. M., on the 26th, the party at Colver's house closed, and Colver, Cross, Hannan, Forbes and Fitzhugh, all young men, went over to attend the ball at Mr. Champlain's. They got there about 3 o'clock, A. M. In a short time a row occurred between Bennett and Colver, on the ball room floor, which was the second floor of the house. Colver knocked Bennett down, and a terrible scene followed. No one knows exactly how this one or that one got hurt; but the fact is, when order was restored, Baranger was found dead. Ashford Clayton was shot in two places, and bruised on the head by a blow from a dragon pistol; Colver was stabbed in the lung; Forbes was shot and otherwise injured; Hannan was shot in the back; Cross was the escape. It is doubtful whether Forbes, Clayton or Colver will ever recover. There were only two shots fired by the Colver party, and these are accounted for. Fitzhugh did not kill Baranger. Baranger was killed by a shot that was intended for Colver, who stood near Baranger when he was killed. The two near Baranger when the Colver party were fired by Fitzhugh in defense of his life, and they were fired after Baranger was shot, and in an opposite direction from where Baranger was standing. There were eight or ten shots fired altogether. All but two shots were fired by Bennett's party. It is known that Baranger had an enemy at that ball. He was buried by the Odd Fellows. This whole matter will undergo a legal investigation. There was no whisky at either ball.

Cholera on the Isthmus. NEW YORK, Jan. 12.—The steamer San Francisco arrived to-day from Nicaragua, with passengers 224 days out. Mark Twain says that at San Juan del Sur he found 700 passengers from the Santiago. Three hundred of the soldiers were left behind by the Mossa Taylor.

A placard was posted on the ship, saying that the cholera was very bad among the soldiers, and requiring passengers to remain on board until the next steamer. The next day he found the steamer San Francisco at Greytown, with 600 passengers for the America's trip, 1200 in all. Wild reports were current of deaths from cholera on the Isthmus, reaching 250. After some trouble he got from the President and other officers, official reports and found that only nine passengers and twenty-seven soldiers had died of the cholera. If they remain on the Isthmus the cholera may attack them again. They are so imprudent in eating and drinking, though it is said the disease had stopped when he passed. However, if the America does not carry them all away the cholera is sure to break out again. We do not telegraph this to scare you, but to warn and enable you to take proper precaution.

We left Greytown the 21st. On the next day there were three cases of cholera in the steerage and three deaths from other diseases. There were eight deaths during the whole voyage, including the crew. By the way, the cholera was on the ship, for supplies, but did not alight the fright and distress of the passengers. Many of the steerage passengers were prostrated with diarrhoea. Twenty-one of the most seared passengers deserted the ship there. Infant child of Mrs. Harlan, Sacramento; Jerome Shields, Andrew Latan, Martin Sherlock, Captain Chas. Mahoney, Chas. Delmayne, P. Peter son, and Rev. Mr. Fairer, Episcopal Clergyman.

S. A. second in command of the troops detained on the Isthmus of Nicaragua, died of cholera. His remains have been brought back by the steamer arriving this morning.

GOVERNOR LYON, OF IDAHO, IS ARRESTED.—Publication was recently made that Caleb Lyon, of Lewiston, New York, who has been Governor of the Territory of Idaho for several years past, while on his way to this city from New York, in the night train, was robbed of the sum of forty-seven thousand dollars, Government funds, which he held as Superintendent of Indian Affairs of that Territory. Governor Lyon says he put the sum of money named in a belt, (which for protection sake, should be worn around the body), but that when he laid down in the sleeping car he put the belt under his head; that the thief took the money and left the belt exactly where the Governor put it. To say the least, this was a considerable sum of money, and the loss of the Governor's head. What makes the statement about the loss of the money seem very strange is the fact that Mr. Lyon should have allowed himself to bring such a large amount of money upon his person to this city. There was no occasion for it. He could have deposited it in any Government depository and taken a receipt for it; or, for the stealing of which would not necessarily have subjected him to the loss of the money.

It will appear by the record, we understand, that since July 28, 1864, the Government has advanced to Superintendent Lyon, at different times, about one hundred thousand dollars, for which he has never rendered any account whatever. Therefore Governor Lyon will not only have to account to the Government for the \$47,000 taken from the belt under his head, but for the still larger sum named above, the disbursement of which there is no official detail rendering at the present time. We certainly hope Governor Lyon will make a satisfactory settlement of the financial affairs of his administration to the public, reference to which we thus allude to publicly because the subject is a public one, and will probably be brought before the courts at an early day.—Washington Republican.

THE ANTIQUITY OF EARTH.—Geologists have advanced another proof of the great antiquity of the world. In the year 1819, if we are to believe Dr. John, Admiral Sir David Milne visited a sea grotto in the Bermudas, and cut down and carried away as a trophy, a stalagmite, of natural crystalline limestone. The son of Admiral Milne, who visited the famous grotto of the Bermudas, and on examination, he found that another stalagmite had begun to grow in the place of the one cut down and carried away. This fact attracted the attention of geologists; and led to a scientific investigation into the peculiarities and natural formation of the grotto. Two drops of water fell four times a minute upon the spot, where, what Dr. Jouin indignantly pronounced as a theft, was committed. By a careful measurement of the young stalagmite, and an elaborate computation, it is ascertained that the pillar now in Edinburgh was the growth of 600,000 years.

Earthquake at Fort Klamath. JACKSONVILLE, Oregon, Jan. 13.—The following letter is to the Oregon Sentinel, sent from Fort Klamath, dated January 8th:
