

2005 Washington Preservation Assessment Grants

The Washington Preservation Initiative assists Washington state libraries of all types and sizes in preserving collections of materials with significant historical or cultural value, thus assuring the long-term access to these collections.

This grant cycle provides limited consulting services that will result in a preservation needs assessment of the library. The purpose of the assessment is to broadly identify potential threats to the longevity of the collection, to identify the extent of preservation problems and areas of acute need, and to develop recommendations that the library may follow in instituting a basic program of preservation.
