OUR HISTORY

The Washington State Combined Fund Drive continues to take the lead as one of our nation's only independent workplace giving programs for public, higher education and retired employees. Utilizing the CFD, employees can give to a charity of their choice through payroll contribution and agency fundraising events.

To date, donors have pledged more than \$135 million to charities in their communities and throughout the world, changing the lives of those in need.

The CFD was established in 1984 as an Executive Order under Governor Spellman.

In 2000, the state Ethics Board deemed the CFD an official part of state business, meaning CFD volunteers are allowed to visit our website, manage their personal donations, and plan and execute fundraising events for CFD during work hours.

OUR CAMPAIGN

The Annual CFD giving campaign runs from the beginning of October through December and is administered in over 200 agencies and higher education institutions.

The CFD County Committees hold fundraisers throughout our state to help raise donations for charities in the CFD.



A HERO'S RESPONSIBILITIES



LEAD.

A CFD Campaign Leader is an employee who is appointed by their respective state agency director, or higher education president, to lead the CFD effort in their workplace. Successful Campaign Leaders are enthusiastic, connected, creative and collaborative.

ACT.

Recruit.

A campaign the size of the CFD cannot be accomplished at an agency level by one employee. We encourage all Campaign Leaders to recruit as many volunteers as possible throughout the state to assist with the Annual Giving Campaign.

Communicate.

Each Campaign Leader shares CFD news with fellow workplace employees and executive management. They are available to answer questions and help promote a positive image of the CFD.

Fundraise.

Campaign Leaders manage all fundraising activities within their agency or campus and log those fundraisers into the CFD system at the end of the campaign.
