



## Declared Write-In Candidates for 2012 State Primary

The citizens of Washington State enjoy a unique tradition of citizen involvement in elections. The ability to write in the name of a person not printed on a ballot has been an essential part that tradition.

The names of write-in candidates are not printed on ballots. To cast a vote for write-in candidate supporters must write in the name of the candidate for a specific office.

Votes cast for write-in candidates are reported as a cumulative total for all write-in votes. Write-in votes cast are not reported on the SOS website.

Only if the total number of write-in votes cast in a race might change the outcome of the race, will write-in votes be tallied and reported for individual candidates.
