[PROPOSED] ORDER
GRANTING MOTION TO
RECOVER ATTORNEY FEES
AND FOR COSTS

1 This Court has considered the State's Motion to Recover Attorney Fees And For
2 Costs, as well as all declarations, responses, and replies related thereto, and finds that the
3 State is entitled to a full refund of all attorneys' fees paid to Plaintiffs and Plaintiff
4 Intervenor.

5 Judgment is awarded in favor of the State of Washington as follows:

- 6 1. The Washington State Republican Party, and its officials named as Plaintiffs in
7 this action, shall pay to the State of Washington \$54,457.65 (attorneys' fees) and
8 \$639.60 (costs), for a total monetary judgment of \$55,097.25;
- 9 2. The Washington Democratic Central Committee, and its officials named as
10 Plaintiff Intervenor in this action, shall pay to the State of Washington
11 \$37,460.77 (attorneys' fees) and \$213.20 (costs), for a total monetary judgment of
12 \$37,673.97;
- 13 3. The Libertarian Party of Washington State, and its officials named as Plaintiff
14 Intervenor in this action, shall pay to the State of Washington \$14,977.80
15 (attorneys' fees) and \$1,323.32 (costs), for a total monetary judgment of
16 \$16,301.12;
- 17 4. In addition, the Plaintiffs and Plaintiff Intervenor shall be jointly and severally
18 liable to pay the State of Washington an additional \$306.78, reflecting an award
19 of costs in favor of the State of Washington on appeal to the Ninth Circuit in this
20 action; and
- 21 5. Post-judgment interest shall accrue on these amounts at the statutory rate.
