1 The State of Washington and Defendant-Intervenors, and the Washington State
2 Republican Party and Plaintiff-Intervenors, by and through their respective counsel of record,
3 stipulate and agree as follows:

5 **STIPULATION**

6 1. Previously, this Court moved the trial date to November 15, 2010.

7 2. At the parties' stipulated agreement and request, per the Court's August 26, 2010,
8 Order, the due date for trial briefs was rescheduled to November 11, 2010. However, the
9 parties neglected to request that the due date for lodging the pretrial order also be changed.
10 Currently, the due date for the pretrial order is September 24, 2010, approximately seven
11 weeks before trial.

12 3. The Parties believe it is in the interest of the Court, as well as the parties, that
13 the pretrial order be due on November 5, 2010, the Friday before trial briefs are due, and two
14 Fridays prior to the start of trial. This change would replicate the timing the Court originally
15 established for the pretrial order, trial briefs, and trial, in the status conference of October 20,
16 2009.

17 4. The Court has the authority and discretion to grant this stipulated order pursuant
18 to, *inter alia*, Fed. R. Civ. P. 16.

2 5, 2010.
