Re: Referendum Measure No. 92

Dear Ms. Wyman:

Referendum Measure No. 92 is a referendum for submission to the people. In accordance with RCW 29A.72.060, we supply herewith the ballot title and ballot measure summary for Referendum Measure No. 92 (act relating to reducing greenhouse gas emissions by reducing the carbon intensity of transportation fuel).

If this measure qualifies to appear on the ballot, it will bear the following ballot title, including the bracketed language which need not appear on the petitions:

BALLOT TITLE

<u>Statement of Subject</u>: The legislature passed Engrossed Third Substitute House Bill 1091 concerning greenhouse gas emissions and transportation fuel [and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill].

<u>Concise Description</u>: This bill would authorize a "Clean Fuels Program" to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from fuels used for transportation, create incentives for fuel suppliers to sell low-carbon fuels, and provide funding for electricity infrastructure.

BALLOT MEASURE SUMMARY

This bill authorizes establishment of a "Clean Fuels Program" to reduce aggregate greenhouse gas emissions per unit of transportation fuel by 20 percent below 2017 levels by 2038, and to provide funding for electricity infrastructure. The program must provide incentives, including tax-exempt credits, to support the production and sale of low-carbon fuels by regulated producers or importers of covered transportation fuels, and must allow deferred compliance under certain circumstances. It requires several annual public reports.
