1 **Initiative 1518:**

2 **BALLOT TITLE**

3 Statement of Subject: Initiative Measure No. 1518 concerns labor standards.

4 Concise Description: This measure would increase the state minimum wage to \$10.50 in 2017,
5 \$11.00 in 2018, \$11.50 in 2019, and \$12.00 in 2020; allow lower training-wages; require paid
6 sick leave; and adopt related laws.

8 **BALLOT MEASURE SUMMARY**

9 This measure would increase the state hourly minimum wage for employees who are at least
10 18 to \$10.50 in 2017, \$11.00 in 2018, \$11.50 in 2019, and \$12.00 in 2020, and allow temporary
11 training wages starting at \$9.50 per hour. It would require employers to provide paid sick leave
12 starting in 2018 for use in certain circumstances, including to care for family members or for
13 bereavement. It also authorizes related agency rules.
