## **BALLOT TITLE**

<u>Statement of Subject</u>: The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5842 concerning the state Climate Commitment Act [and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on part of this act].

<u>Concise Description</u>: The part of this bill subject to referendum would clarify the mechanism and timing by which certain entities that are subject to regulation under the state Climate Commitment Act must demonstrate compliance with existing obligations under that Act.

## **BALLOT MEASURE SUMMARY**

The part of this bill subject to referendum would amend the 2021 Climate Commitment Act, which directed the Department of Ecology to implement a "cap-and-invest" program to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Specifically, it would clarify the mechanism and timing by which certain entities subject to regulation under the Climate Commitment Act must demonstrate compliance with existing obligations under that Act, including providing for annual transfer of compliance instruments during the Act's four-year compliance period.
