## **BALLOT MEASURE SUMMARY**

Third Substitute House Bill 1491 requires that cities permit high-density housing developments near public transit stations, with certain exceptions. High density development must be allowed within one-half mile walking distance of a qualifying train station and one-quarter mile walking distance of a qualifying bus station. Housing developments within these areas must offer a

certain amount of lower cost housing, and the measure provides incentives, including tax exemptions, to increase the supply of lower cost housing.
