

# 2010 Census Data Files

- Redistricting File - - released
  - State and sub-state counts down to the block level are shown for the total population and the population 18 years and over for 63 race groups and Hispanic or Latino origin; and not Hispanic or Latino by 63 race groups. (Released: February 3-March 24, 2011)
- Summary File 1 - - released
  - This file shows detailed tables on age, sex, households, families, relationship to householder, housing units, detailed race and Hispanic or Latino origin groups, and group quarters. Most tables are shown down to the block or census tract level. (Released: June 16 -August 25, 2011)
- Summary File 2 - - ***WA to be released Thursday, 02-09***
  - This file shows detailed tables on age, sex, households, families, relationship to householder, housing units, and group quarters. Most tables are shown down to the census tract level. Tables are repeated by 75 major race groups, 114 American Indian and Alaska Native groups, 47 Asian groups, 43 Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander groups, and 51 Hispanic or Latino origin groups. (Released: December 15, 2011-April 2012)



## Overview: Library Statistics

The **Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS)** and the **National Center for Education Statistics (NCES)** sponsor surveys about libraries. The U.S. Census Bureau acts as the collection agent for these surveys, but the data themselves are available through the sponsoring agency.

The data provided to the IMLS and the NCES are used for a wide range of purposes including research, policy development, and legislative action.

### IMLS—sponsored surveys

#### Public Libraries Survey

Collects **nationwide** descriptive statistics on all public libraries in the United States.

#### State Library Agencies Survey

Collects data from the official state library agencies charged with state-wide library development and the administration of federal funds authorized by the Library Services and Technology Act.

### NCES—sponsored surveys

#### Academic Libraries Survey

Collects data from libraries of **postsecondary** institutions.

The Census Bureau reports poverty data from several major household surveys and programs. The Annual Social and Economic Supplement (ASEC) to the Current Population Survey (CPS) is the source of official national poverty estimates. The American Community Survey (ACS) provides single and multi-year estimates for smaller areas. The Survey of Income and Program Participation (SIPP) provides longitudinal estimates. The Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates (SAIPE) program provides model-based poverty estimates for counties and school districts. 


