

## 2013 Connecting Libraries through Resource Sharing Grants

The purpose of the Connecting Libraries through Resource Sharing (CLRS) grant cycle is to encourage cooperation among public libraries in counties, or those with contiguous borders, where inter-local agreements to share materials do not exist, by providing grant funds for collection development with materials to be rotated between partnering libraries.

Overall funding to support the 2013 CLRS grant cycle is \$8,235. The funds will be awarded equally among partners with a maximum award of \$715 dollars per library, including \$500 for collection development, up to \$140 for travel to attend two required meetings, and up to \$75 for processing materials
