Section III: ARSL 2015 Scholarship Budget

The value of the scholarship is approximately \$2,000. The Washington State Library will arrange and pay directly for the following expenses:

- Membership for one year in ARSL and registration for the ARSL 2015 Conference
- Air travel arrangements on an approved provider under state contract
- Lodging at the conference hotel.

A travel claim should be made by the library for miscellaneous expenses such as meals not covered by the conference, mileage, parking, taxis, shuttles, etc. Please refer to the ARSL 2015 Scholarship Grant Claim Instructions sent to you with your award letter for complete information on allowable expenses and acceptable documentation.

Additional meals are reimbursed at the rate appropriate for your stage of travel. Rates for Little Rock, Arkansas are currently rate of \$61 per day (\$15 breakfast, \$18 lunch and \$28 dinner). Mileage is reimbursed at the state travel rate which is currently \$0.575 per mile. Rates are subject to change periodically.
