

The following notes pertain to all sections of the 2011 Washington Public Library Statistical Report.

- a) Population figures are based on the State of Washington, Office of Financial Management publication: 2011 Population Trends, November 2011.
- b) Percent of Change figures are calculated by comparing 2011 numbers against 2010, using the following formula:  
$$(2011 \text{ value} - 2010 \text{ value}) / 2010 \text{ value}.$$
- c) Subtotals are the calculation for each library population grouping and the Grand Total is the calculation for all libraries in the state.
- d) Assessed valuation figures are based on data from the Department of Revenue publication: Property Tax Statistics 2011: August 2011.
- e) Assessed valuation and local revenues of library districts include annexed areas.
- f) Regular Levy Rates are actual levy rates for library districts. In cases where the library system receives Revenue from multiple taxing districts with varying levy rates, the weighted average levy rate was calculated.
- g) Local Cents per \$1,000 is the calculated levy rate for cities, using the following formula:  
$$(\text{Local Jurisdiction Revenue} / \text{Assessed Municipal Valuations}) * 1000.$$
- h) 2012 Salary Figures (Table 20) are shown in dollars per hour.
- i) The Salary and Compensation Survey was combined with the Annual Statistical Data Survey for ease of submission for libraries. As a result, the data for the Salary and Compensation Survey uses 2012 figures, whereas the Annual Statistical Data Survey uses 2011.
