Library Now Timeline


- The app is live on multiple platforms now

- Formal launch in January with statewide Internet “keyword” marketing campaign



- Closest library first






- Libraries with standalone Boopsie apps are also listed:




- The Library Now app directs users to the stand-alone app



- Type a letter or two to narrow your choices
- Typed “t”
- Retrieves all entries that have a word starting with that letter



- Typing two letters will often narrow your choices to just one or two libraries
- Typed “ti”






Searching the Catalog

- Note the example search
- Uses Boopsie's patented Smart Prefix Search technology
- Requires libraries to provide MARC record data dump to Boopsie regularly



Searching

- The app guesses at your intention
- Note highlighted choice (Android)
- Enforce your intent, otherwise results can shift



Searching

- Extend the process to multiple word searches
- Just type the first couple letters of each desired word


BookLook Feature


