

To download EPUB e-books or MP3 audiobooks to your Kindle Fire:

Install the OverDrive Media Console (OMC) Android App on your Kindle Fire. It is not available in the Amazon Market. Instead, go to <http://overdrive.com/Software/omc/> and click on "Download OverDrive Media Console for Android from OverDrive."

Be sure you have allowed installations of apps on your Kindle Fire. Here are the steps to do so: 1. From the Home screen, tap the 'Quick Settings' icon and select More. 2. Tap Device. 3. Turn the switch for "Allow Installation of Applications" to the "on" position.

Notes:

To read EPUB eBooks you'll also need to register for a free Adobe ID (<http://adobe.com>) and authorize the OMC app with that email address and password. To find the Adobe registration area on the Fire, tap the small menu button at the bottom-center of the Fire's touch screen >> App Settings.

You cannot use WMA audiobooks with the Kindle Fire. The WMA audiobooks have DRM (security) developed by Microsoft. The DRM requires Windows Media Player to unlock the security. There is no WMP on the Fire.

How to return the EPUB eBook* early on the Fire's OverDrive Media Console:

From the "Home" screen of the Fire's OMC app (the one where you see all of the titles listed...)

Tap and press on the title until a new menu pops up.

Tap "Delete."

Tap "Return Then Delete."

The title will be returned to the collection and your account freed up for another ebook. Note: audiobooks cannot be returned early.
