

Washington State Medal of Valor

NOMINEE APPLICATION

The Washington State Medal of Valor is bestowed by the Governor "to any person who has saved, or attempted to save, the life of another at the risk of serious injury or death to himself or herself." This medal cannot be awarded to any individual who is acting as a result of service in "law enforcement, fire fighting, rescue or other hazardous profession where the individual is employed by a government entity within the state of Washington."

Recipients of the Medal of Valor are selected by the State Medal of Valor Committee, which includes the:

Governor:

President of the Senate (Lieutenant Governor); Speaker of the House of Representatives; and Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

The Secretary of State serves as a non-voting ex-officio member and secretary of the committee. Further information concerning the Medal of Valor is available at:
