The above-named defendant has complied with the conditions of probation imposed by the Order of the Court heretofore made and entered in this case. The defendant's adjustment in complying with the rules of probation and conditions imposed by the Court has been satisfactory.

Comments: William Tuttle is currently on parole for charges that were pending at the time Klickitat County granted him probation. According to the Klickitat County Clerk's Office, Tuttle was not ordered to pay Court costs. Also, restitution was taken care of prior to sentencing. This was verified by the Klickitat County Prosecutor's Office. They report that their files show that the banks recovered the money owed them. Record checks with local law enforcement agencies reflect that Tuttle has had no contact with their agencies since paroling and having his probation reactivated. He works 32 hours a week for Port of Pasco Cafe and has maintained a stable residence in Kennewick. It is recommended that William E. Tuttle be granted a Dismissal.

It is respectfully requested that the defendant be permitted to change the finding or plea of "Guilty" to "Not Guilty," be discharged from probation and that all proceedings in this case be terminated.

On this 20th day of April, 1981, L. Eugene Hanson, Prosecuting Attorney for the County of Klickitat, being personally present and representing the State of Washington, and the Defendant William E. Tuttle, being personally present with attorney Joy Van Nostern, it appears to the satisfaction of this Court that the said Defendant has been charged by Information with the crime of Unlawful Issuance of Check committed on or about the 13th day of March, 1981, in Klickitat County, Washington, to which Information the said Defendant entered a plea of "guilty" on the 20th day of April, 1981, and the Court being fully advised in the premises and having determined that the Defendant is eligible under the laws of the State of Washington to have the imposition of his sentence deferred and to be placed on probation, and having further determined that the ends of justice can best be met by such disposition;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THIS COURT that the Defendant William E. Tuttle, is guilty of the crime of Unlawful Issuance of Check as charged, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the imposition of the sentence of the above-named Defendant be deferred for a period of three (3) years from the date hereof upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

1 1. That the Defendant is placed on probation to the Department  
2 of Social & Health Services of the State of Washington for a period  
3 of 3 years from the date hereof unless such period be changed by  
4 further order of this Court; the Defendant shall be under the custody  
5 and control of said Department and shall be required to implicitly  
6 follow the instructions, rules and regulations promulgated by said  
7 Department during the period of his probation herein;

8 2. That defendant shall serve 90 days in the Klickitat County  
9 Jail, defendant shall receive credit for time served.

10 3. Defendant shall make full restitution to Klickitat Valley  
11 Bank of Goldendale, Washington and Rainier Bank of White Salmon,  
12 Washington.

13 4. Defendant shall sign a Waiver of Extradition to Jackson  
14 County, Mississippi but shall first be transferred to other jurisdic-  
15 tions in the State of Washington having holds on defendant.

16 5. Defendant shall affix his fingerprints to this document.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court retains continuous  
18 jurisdiction of this case and the Defendant and that this order shall  
19 remain in full force and effect until further order of the Court  
20 revoking, modifying, changing or terminating said probation;

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the said Defendant fails, refuses  
22 and/or neglects to strictly comply with the terms and conditions  
23 herein set forth, he shall be subject to immediate apprehension and the  
24 imposition and execution of sentence according to his plea of guilty  
25 to the crime charged.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the said Defendant fulfills and  
27 faithfully complies with all of the terms and conditions herein set  
28 forth, he may, at the expiration of the period of probation, be per-  
29 mitted, in the sound discretion of this Court, to withdraw his plea  
30 of guilty and enter a plea of not guilty and this Court may thereupon  
31 dismiss the Information filed herein and if such is done, the said  
32 Defendant shall thereafter be released from all penalties and dis-  
abilities resulting from this offense;
