**II. JUDGMENT**

Based upon this Court's oral ruling of dismissal on June 6, 2005 and the records and files herein, and having reviewed the WSDCC's Motion for Costs Under RCW 29.68.060, all briefing and declarations filed in support of or opposition thereto, and any reply, and being fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

- 1. On June 6, 2005, this Court dismissed this election contest petition with prejudice and confirmed the certification of Christine Gregoire as the duly elected Governor of Washington State.
- 2. Pursuant to RCW 29.68.060, WSDCC is awarded its reasonable costs in the amount of \$ 15,000.00 and judgment is hereby entered in that amount in favor of the WSDCC and against Petitioners the Rossi for Governor Campaign.
- 3. Pursuant to RCW 4.56.110 and 19.52.020, this judgment shall bear interest at the judgment interest rate of 12% from July 8, 2005, forward and until fully satisfied.


