

INITIATIVE 758

I, Sam Reed, Secretary of State of the State of Washington and custodian of its seal, hereby certify that, according to the records on file in my office, the attached copy of Initiative Measure No. 758 to the People is a true and correct copy as it was received by this office.

1 AN ACT Relating to contracts creating private monopolies; and
2 creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** All unconstitutional contracts creating
5 private monopolies of public resources are forever void. Anyone
6 attempting to enforce such contract is subject to a one thousand dollar
7 a day fine.

8 The people recognize that the Constitution prohibits monopolies and
9 trusts. Any contract creating a monopoly is therefore repugnant and
10 void. Anyone attempting to molest the Constitution and enforce such
11 contract is personally subject to a one thousand dollar a day judgment
12 paid to anyone who can prove the attempt of enforcement of such
13 contract in superior court.
