

INITIATIVE 759

I, Sam Reed, Secretary of State of the State of Washington and custodian of its seal, hereby certify that, according to the records on file in my office, the attached copy of Initiative Measure No. 759 to the People is a true and correct copy as it was received by this office.

1 AN ACT Relating to the bar association; creating a new section; and
2 repealing RCW 2.48.170.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The people intend to ensure that all people
5 are truly free and equal by repealing all unconstitutional laws
6 granting any private club/union/bar association control and perversion
7 of our legal system, ensuring that all people be equal in the pursuit
8 of justice and public office such as prosecutor and judge, ending an
9 evil monopoly of corruption and abuse by enforcing Washington's
10 Constitution, Article I, sections 1, 4, 5, 8, 12, 19, 22, and 32, and
11 eliminating all special, secret powers, privileges, immunities, and
12 entitlements bar members now have.

13 Attorneys operating for hire shall be required to pass a
14 standardized test based solely on published court rules administered by
15 the department of licensing to receive a Washington state business
16 license to operate as an attorney for hire. Attorneys for hire shall
17 be disciplined only by a citizens review panel. Judges shall be
18 limited in only making recommendation for discipline to a citizen
19 review panel for attorney for hire discipline.

1 Membership in a bar association is eliminated as a requirement to
2 hold public office, exercise free speech, and represent others in
3 court.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** RCW 2.48.170 (Only active members may
5 practice law) and 1933 c 94 s 13 are each repealed.
