**CURRENT EVENTS.**  
Milan, King of Servia, has accepted the resignation of his ministry.  
Baneroff, the historian, celebrated his eighty-third birthday on the 23d inst.  
The Inter-State League Convention is in session at Vicksburg, Miss.  
General Hancock is convalescing rapidly.  
It is thought the officers will succeed in getting hold of the men guilty of the attack on the train at Coolidge. One of those now in custody is thought to be the leader in the affair.  
William Diver, a deaf mute, attempted to kill his sister-in-law, a widow, for refusing to marry him.  
A passenger from Liverpool on the Lydian Monarch was arrested when the vessel reached New York on a charge of forgery.  
A woman in Chicago jumped from the fifth story of a building and died in a few minutes.  
At Bridgeport, Pa., a burglar was fatally shot while attempting to rob a hotel.  
At Trenton, N. J., two ladies, each 70 years old, were killed while walking on a railroad track.  
Three men have been arrested charged with Postoffice robberies in Massachusetts and Connecticut.  
At Comanche, Texas, three men quarreled in a meeting-house, and one was killed another dangerously wounded.  
The annual meeting of the American Board of Foreign Missions is in progress at Boston.
