The Irish Citizens of California have rendered thanks to the Legislature for its resolution asking Congress to endeavor to obtain the liberation of English men and women who are detained in Great Britain for political offenses.

Silver is in demand in England.

Daniel Drew, of Wall street fame, has filed a petition in bankruptcy. His liabilities amount to \$600,000.

The committee on expenditures of the War Department will subpoena Mrs. Belknap to appear before them.

The new clearing house was opened at San Francisco on the morning of the 11th. A large amount of business was done.

A Cincinnati dispatch of the 9th inst. says: The new Secretary of War, Judge Taft, leaves for Washington to-night.

When Judge Taft, accompanied by Secretaries Robson and Chandler, called on the President on the morning of the 11th and there met the President, they were accompanied by the new Secretary of War entered upon his duties.

The New York Tribune of the 3d claims that the prime minister in the Belknap scandal in connection with the Fort Sill tradership were traced by its correspondent to the door of the War Department in 1870, and deduced from the failure to investigate the facts the President's responsibility.

Luttrell has presented to the Secretary of the Interior a number of affidavits charging Indian Agent Burdard, of Round Valley reservation, with dishonesty and general infamance in office, and says if the Department will employ a resident he will bring the matter to the attention of Congress.

The House Committee on Public Lands has agreed to recommend the passage of the bill providing for the issue of patents for mission claims in Oregon, Washington, Idaho and Montana.

At the investigation, on the 10th of the affair at the District of Columbia, one witness testified that he put down about 8,000 yards of paving, amounting to \$16,000, and he had never received any money but glass of ale and a cigar. C. P. Finley & Stewart were the contractors.

Babcock's retirement from the White House is likely to be followed by his resignation from the army. It is asserted that he has already been deceived in him. Col. F. Grant has been ordered to rejoin his command in the Yellowstone country.

The Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections have been discussing the proposition for a constitutional amendment providing for the election of the President and Vice-President by the direct vote of the people.

Orville Grant, brother of the President, was before the Committee on Expenditures in the War Department on the 10th inst. He was not interested with any parties who obtained appointments of post-traderships from the Secretary of War. He said he was interested in contracting under the Indian Department that he obtained a post on his own account from Commissioner Smith. The President notified him there would be vacancies at Fort Peck, Fort Belknap and Seaside Park, and he applied for these places in pursuance of the knowledge given him by the President's Expenditure office from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs after seeing the Secretary of the Interior. Neither the President nor Secretary of the Interior had the slightest knowledge of his receiving money. Witnesses testified that he was now in the employ of Barber & Co., of Baltimore, with a salary of \$200 per month.

The bill to enable the people of New Mexico to form a constitution and State government and for the admission of the same to the Union on an equal footing with the original States, was amended and passed by the Senate, on the 10th, by a vote of 72 yeas to 23 nays. It shall be republican in form, and shall be submitted to the people of the Territory for ratification or rejection at a election to be held in November next, and if ratified the Governor shall certify the same to the President of the United States, who shall thereupon issue a proclamation declaring the State admitted without any further action whatever on the part of Congress.

The President has sent to the Senate the name of Blackwell, of Massachusetts as successor to R. C. Schenck, Minister to England, resigned.
