Letter From Boise.

PLACERVILLE, BOISE MINES, March 17, 1863. ED. STATESMAN - Through your paper I desire to enlighten the public upon the road and distances from Walla Walla to this place, also to what I know of this great mining region.

From Walla Walla city to Walla Walla river, 1/2 mile. Walla Walla river to No. 10 Horse Creek, 1/2 mile. No. 10 Horse Creek to Lemhi river, 1/2 mile.

There is good grass and plenty of wood and water at all the encampments named, except Lee's Encampment. Grand Round river and Round Creek, in Powder river valley. At these places there was no grass when we passed.

A trip from Walla Walla to Boise mines would only be a trip of pleasure in summer time, if it were not for the water courses. I would advise those who intend to come here to start before the waters rise in Burnt river; for it is a "washable" stream and has to be crossed eleven times.
