



1 3. Respondent has recently registered as a charitable organization with the Charities
2 Division of the Washington Secretary of State and agrees to maintain registration status with the
3 Washington Secretary of State for as long as it is required by law to do so.

4 4. Respondent agrees to pay the costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the
5 Attorney General in pursuing this matter in the amount of \$500.00 (FIVE HUNDRED
6 DOLLARS), payable in full upon signing this Assurance of Discontinuance. Payment shall be
7 made by valid cashier's check, paid to the order of Attorney General—State of Washington.

8 5. Respondent shall send the signed Assurance of Discontinuance, the Order, and a
9 cashier's check to the Office of the Attorney General, Attention: Margaret Farmer, Consumer
10 Protection Division, 800 Fifth Avenue, Suite 2000, Seattle, Washington, 98104.

11 6. This Assurance of Discontinuance shall not be considered an admission of
12 violation of the Consumer Protection Act or the Charitable Solicitations Act for any purpose, but
13 failure to comply with this Assurance of Discontinuance shall be *prima facie* evidence of violation
14 of RCW 19.86.020, for which the violator, Silver Flight Ensembles, and its officers, directors, and
15 principals, may be found liable by the Court for injunctions, restitution, civil penalties of up to
16 \$2,000.00 per violation, and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Attorney
17 General in pursuing such action.

18 7. Under no circumstances may this Assurance of Discontinuance or the name of the State of
19 Washington, the Office of the Attorney General, the Washington Secretary of State, or any of its
20 employees or representatives be used by the Respondent or by its officers, employees,
21 representatives, or agents in conjunction with any business or charitable activity of the
22 Respondent, including but not limited to claiming that the State has approved of Respondent's
23 business, charitable, or charitable solicitation practices.

8. Nothing in this Assurance of Discontinuance limits or bars any person or entity from pursuing any legal remedies against the Respondent.




